

Espace Urbain / ISAC looks for a new head of the department (professeur titulaire), and a new teaching assistant for the academic year 2019-2020.

We welcome individual applications for each position, while being open also to joint applications for the two positions to form a duo.



Established in 2012, ArBA EsA's Espace Urbain / ISAC trains artists through body and dance practices as a means of research and expression for their artistic creations.

Espace Urbain / ISAC is the dance, performance and choreography department of the Royal Art Academy in Brussels, inhabiting a space between choreography and the visual arts. It forms artists that use both the body and an expanded idea of choreography as primary tool of expression.

Espace Urbain / ISAC is based on an a pedagogy in which daily physical involvement mingles with both visual art and theoretical reflections; a context where the body becomes a tool for reflection, and art an instrument of thinking the present.

Head of the Department (f/m/x) is

- in charge of defining the future pedagogy of Espace Urbain / ISAC
- being responsible for the functioning of the department
- follow and mentoring the work of the students
- defining the program and the invited artists for each year
- managing the budget for the activities of the department
- coordinating the relations with other Brussels-based and international institutions
- defining the politics of the department

Requirement

- education / master in an artistic practice, in the field of performance or choreography (If the diploma is not in the field of plastic and visual arts and space, you must ask for a notoriety with the Wallonia-Brussels Federation)
- knowledge about contemporary choreography, visual and performing arts
- knowledge to develop a network of collaborations and partnerships with local and international art institutions.
- experience in pedagogy
- administrative skills
- being fluent in French and English



The position of Head of the Department is 6/12 (half-time position, equivalent to 2 days per week). She/he works in close collaboration with the artistic responsible of ISAC and coordinator of the Academy (Enzo Pezzella) and the assisting teacher.

Shortlisted candidate will be contacted for an interview. Final decision will be taken by the end of May 2019.

Assisting Teacher (f/m/x) is

- in charge of mentoring the students
- defining the program together with the head of the department
- coordinating the relation with the spaces and institutions linked with Espace Urbain / ISAC
- coordinating the access and use of the technical material for the students
- producer of the different activities of the program Espace Urbain / ISAC (master classes, festival)
- in charge of the communication (website, facebook) of Espace Urbain / ISAC
- coordinating Open ISAC

Requirement:

- education / master in an artistic practice, in the field of performance or choreography (If the diploma is not in the field of plastic and visual arts and space, you must ask for a notoriety with the Wallonia-Brussels Federation)
- experience in pedagogy
- knowledge about contemporary choreography, visual and performing arts
- administrative skills
- being fluent in French and English

The position of assisting teacher is 10/20. She/he works in close collaboration with the head of the department and the artistic responsible of ISAC and coordinator of the Academy (Enzo Pezzella).

In order to submit your application, please fill in the following document, adding a motivation letter including an artistic and pedagogical vision, a CV with artistic and educational records, certificates of Master diploma. If the diploma has been issued outside of Belgium, an equivalence (from the Wallonia-Brussels Federation) of the master diploma for diplomas obtained outside Belgium or an equivalence (from the Wallonia-Brussels Federation) of any relevant experience outside teaching will be required.
